2. Resume that details all that you have done in choir.
  - a. Awards (Solo and Ensemble, All-Region, All-State, End of year awards....)
  - b. Choir Placements (Concert Choir, Advanced Women, Chorale, Cy-Fair Singers)
  - c. Volunteering (Middle School Region, Car Wash, etc)
  - d. Volunteering outside of the choir program.
  - e. Offices Held on Choir Council
  - f. Anything else you think the committee needs to know about you
3. An essay of 350 words or less of why music is important to you and how this scholarship will help you.

Applications must be turned in to Mr. Likos, Mr. Key or Mrs. Fiorini by Friday, May 3rd. No late applications will be accepted, so please get them in by the deadline. Students will be notified before school lets out if they are the recipient of a voice scholarship.
