Lillian Gist

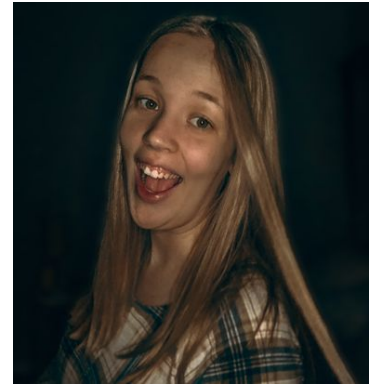
