Cy-Fair Choir will travel to Orlando this year for our Spring Trip! All students are invited to attend this trip; it is not a requirement. This letter is meant to provide information about the trip, pricing, and due dates.

Thursday, April 15

Travel Day. Flight #TBD departs Bush Intercontinental (IAH) at TBD. Arrive at Orlando International at TBD. Students will go to school for the entire day. We will meet at the airport.

Friday, April 16

Breakfast at the hotel, Disney Park (Magic Kingdom) with two Meal Coupons for Lunch and Dinner, Disney Workshop. (Round Trip Park Transfer)

Saturday, April 17

Breakfast at hotel, Universal Epic, two \$25 giftcards for Lunch and Dinner. (Round Trip Park Transfer)

Sunday, April 18

Breakfast at hotel, Universal Islands of Adventure, two \$25 giftcards for Lunch and Dinner. (Round Trip Park Transfer)

Monday, April 19

Breakfast at the hotel, Disney Park (Magic Kingdom) with two Meal Coupons for Lunch and Dinner, (Round Trip Park Transfer). Travel Day. Flight #TBD departs Orlando Int'l at TBD. Arrive at IAH at TBD.

Students will have quad occupancy, chaperones will have double occupancy. We will travel via charter buses throughout the weekend.

COST

Estimated Cost Per Student if 30 Cy-Fair Choir Participants Attend: \$2,025

***In an effort to reduce costs on lodging, airfare, and park tickets, we will be traveling with Cy-Falls Choir! The more students who attend the trip, the lower the cost! Please encourage your choir friends to attend if they are able!*

This estimated cost will go up or down depending on the number of travelers and charter buses.

There is a **\$250 non-refundable deposit** required by the company at the time of booking. This is to begin securing lodging, travel, and tickets to attractions.

What's Included? All meals, all tickets and attractions, ALL travel and accommodations, all gratuities.

Payment Schedule

All payments will be made in individual accounts in WeTravel. **There is a \$250 non-refundable deposit required by the company at the time of booking.** This is to begin securing lodging, travel, and tickets to attractions. These prices are subject to change, as the number of students and transportation costs are considered.

We are splitting airfare and hotel costs with Cy-Falls Choir. The more students who attend, the lower the costs. Based on 30 Cy-Fair Choir Students attending the trip, here is a possible payment schedule for the trip:

August 30	\$250 Non-Refundable Enrollment Fee Due
September 15	1st Installment
October 15	2nd Installment
November 15	3rd Installment
January 15*	4th Installment*
February 15	Final Installment Due

*50% of the trip balance must be paid on or before December 19. Failure to do so will result in the participant being canceled from the trip.

Breaking Up Payments

- **TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE SUMMER!** To help with payment installments, if you wish to make payments prior to August 30 – including May, June, and July – you may!
- If you wish to make more, smaller payments throughout the month, you may!
- If you wish to pay more than the indicated amount per month, you may!
- If you would like to receive contributions from others to assist with paying for your trip, you can set-up a Contribution Page (similar to a Go Fund Me) Instructions are on the WeTravel website.

60 days prior to departure, all balances must be paid. Failure to do so may result in late fees and/or possible cancellation of some arrangements.

TRIP INSURANCE, CANCELLATION, COVID, ELIGIBILITY, & CHAPERONES

Trip Insurance is available!

Travel Insured International offers an optional Student Group Protection Plan with a Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) benefit (e.g. Class Failure, Illness, Pandemic, etc.).

Cancellation MUST be made 48 hours or more PRIOR to departure. YOU must purchase the optional CFAR benefit within 14 days of the initial deposit or when payment for the trip is received to insure all non-refundable prepaid trip costs.

A link will be provided through WeTravel if you would like to purchase a Student Group Protection Plan with the CFAR benefit.

Cancellation

At 50 days prior to departure, there are no refunds, no exceptions. All cancellation policies can be found on the WeTravel account portal.

Academic Eligibility

Any academically ineligible kids will not be able to travel to San Antonio with us and will forfeit money put into the trip. At 50 days prior to departure, there are NO refunds, no exceptions.

If a student passes all classes for the 3rd 9-weeks marking period, they will be eligible to attend the trip. After that, it will be up to the student to pass every class on the following progress report to retain travel eligibility.

Because our trip is taking place during the EOC testing window. Students MUST be present for all of their exams prior to travel. If students miss an exam prior to traveling, they will not be allowed to travel because they MUST take their make-up exam. Some students may need to take an exam on the Tuesday we return. This choice is solely up to the discretion of students and their families.

In conjunction with academic eligibility, students must also be in good behavioral standing. Any student receiving a referral, an assignment to DMC or ALC, or requiring disciplinary action, OR students exhibiting any behavior in which the directors deem as a concern for group travel may not go on the Spring Trip and will forfeit money put into the trip, dependent on the travel company's refund policy.

Possession of drugs or alcohol on the trip is strictly prohibited (by students and adults). Any participant violating this rule is subject to immediate expulsion from the tour. In any such case, the student or their parent or guardian is financially responsible for transporting the participant home (via air), and waives any claim for any refund of any portion of the tour cost.

Students will abide by all Cy-Fair ISD, Cy-Fair HS, and Cy-Fair Choir rules and policies as delineated by the Cy-Fair ISD Code of Conduct, Cy-Fair High School, and the Cy-Fair Choir Handbook. Failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in removal from the trip and

disciplinary action. In any such case, the student or their parent or guardian is responsible for transporting the participant home (via air), and waives any claim for any refund of any portion of the tour cost.

Chaperones

The number of chaperones will be determined by the number of students traveling. Chaperones will pay the same trip price as the students, however they will have double occupancy in their room instead of quad occupancy. **Chaperoning is a job to be taken seriously, not a personal vacation.** Please understand that while we deeply appreciate your willingness to help, not every person who would like to chaperone can be a chaperone.

Please contact Mr. Key if you would like to be considered as a chaperone.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE TRIP

The deadline to register is August 30th.

1. **BEFORE ANYTHING:** Read this entire packet, sign it, and return the signed-portion to the choir directors. (Keep the rest for your records.) This **MUST** be done **FIRST**. You may sign, scan, and email OR sign and give the paper to the directors at school.
2. Complete a medical release form and return it to the choir directors. (Scan or return a hard-copy.)
